IMPORTANT NOTICE

Date: July 30, 2004

Rainier View Water Company, Inc. has filed for approval from the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission to implement a conservation rate. This conservation rate will affect customers who use more than 3,000 cubic feet in a month. The new rate will begin with May, 2005 usage. The conservation rate will be in effect only during the warmer months, May through September, of each year. During those months, usage exceeding 3,000 cubic feet will be billed at \$5.00 per 100 cubic feet. This step is necessary to meet water conservation goals established by the Washington State Department of Health and to conserve the Company's resources for all customers. The goal of this conservation rate is to curtail usage, which will help in providing sufficient pressure for all customers during the warm summer months.
