#3 We are utilizing design/build for the gate/lights, so the representation on the drawings was only a schematic. We will provide some lighting angled towards 99th Street and once the details are finalized we'll pass those along for review.

#4 Yes, as seen on the contract drawings supplied the project will install the overhead cantilever warning light system in front of the new crossing arm.

Thanks for sending me a copy of the final plans. Could you provide me with some updated information on the project.

Here's what I need:

- 1) Revised traffic count for NE 72nd Avenue.
- 2) Revised traffic count for NE 99th Street.
- 3) Confirmation that the county is planning on angling the lights located on the gate posts toward oncoming traffic from 99th Street. Paul, my colleague that attended the diagnostic meeting mentioned that the participants were all in agreement that this was necessary.
- 4) Confirmation that the county is installing cantilevers as detailed in the final design plans. The petition filed on September 10, 2004, indicates that the shoulder mounted flashing lights signals will be "relocated" not upgraded to cantilevers, please clarify this.

I will use this information to supplement the petition, otherwise everything looks good.
