



interest, the purposes underlying regulation and applicable statutes. WAC 480-70-071 (1)(c) provides that the Commission may grant an extension of time allowing the Company to file its annual report after the May 1 due date if the Commission receives a request for extension by May 1.

- 7 (5) This matter was brought before the Commission at its regularly scheduled meeting on May 17, 2006.
- 8 (6) After review of the petition filed in Docket TG-060655 by Bainbridge on April 26, 2006, and giving due consideration, the Commission finds that the exemption is reasonable and should be granted.

### ORDER

#### THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- 9 (1) The exemption sought by Bainbridge Disposal, Inc., for an extension until June 1, 2006, to file its 2005 annual report is granted.
- 10 (2) Failure by Bainbridge Disposal, Inc., to file its 2005 annual report by June 1, 2006, may result in the Commission invoking provisions of Chapter 81.04 RCW that provide for penalty assessments.
- 11 (3) The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and Bainbridge Disposal, Inc. to effectuate the provisions of this Order.

The Commissioners, having determined this Order to be consistent with the public interest, directed the Secretary to enter this Order.
