	On May 1, 2006, Yakima Waste Systems, Inc., (Yakima or the Company) filed with the Commission a petition requesting an extension of time to file its 2005 annual report as required by WAC 480-70-071. The Company states it is unable to prepare the report due to the illness of the company president and the recent retirement of the company's accountant. The Company seeks an extension until May 15, 2006.		
	Commission Staff reviewed the request and recommended granting Yakima's request for exemption, on condition that Yakima must file its 2005 annual report no later than June 1, 2006.

ORDER

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- 9 (1) The exemption sought by Yakima Waste Systems, Inc., for an extension until June 1, 2006, to file its 2005 annual report is granted.
- Failure by Yakima Waste Systems, Inc., to file its 2005 annual report by June 1, 2006, may result in the Commission invoking provisions of Chapter 81.04 RCW that provide for penalty assessments.
- 11 (3) The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and Yakima Waste Systems, Inc., to effectuate the provisions of this Order.

The Commissioners, having determined this Order to be consistent with the public interest, directed the Secretary to enter this Order.
