**NOTICE OF IMPENDING REVOCATION OF REGISTRATION
AS A TELECOMMUNICATIONS COMPANY
AND OPPORTUNITY TO REQUEST A HEARING**

Re: Revocation of Telecommunications Registrations for Failure to File Annual Reports and Pay Regulatory Fees; Docket UT-061344

TO ALL TELECOMMUNICATIONS COMPANIES LISTED IN ATTACHMENT A:

Staff of the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (commission) recently conducted its yearly review of annual reports and regulatory fees for telecommunications companies registered in the state of Washington. As a result, commission staff identified the telecommunications companies listed in Attachment A as not complying with regulatory requirements. The companies listed in Attachment A failed to file annual reports for 2005 and failed to pay regulatory fees for 2006. This notice is being served to all companies listed in Attachment A at their last known addresses on file with the commission.

WAC 480-121-060 provides that the commission may revoke a company's registration for good cause after notice and opportunity for a hearing. Good cause includes failure to file an annual report or pay regulatory fees per WAC 480-121-060(1).

If a company listed in Attachment A wishes to avoid revocation of its registration, the company must, within 30 days of service of this notice, take one of two actions. The first option is to obtain regulatory compliance by submitting the delinquent annual reports and paying the delinquent regulatory fees. Annual report forms are available on the commission's Internet web site: <http://www.wutc.wa.gov>. Companies also may obtain annual report forms by contacting the commission by e-mail at annualreports@wutc.wa.gov or telephone at (360)664-1160.

The second option is to request a hearing to demonstrate why the company's registration should not be revoked. All requests for hearing must comply with the commission's procedural rules, contained in WAC 480-07, which are available at the commission's Internet web site: <http://www.wutc.wa.gov>.

Failure to respond within 30 days of this notice will result in the commission entering an order revoking the company's registration without further notice. Unregistered companies are prohibited from providing telecommunications services in the state of Washington.
