

Agency: Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission

Subject of possible rule making: Examine the need to revise and clarify rules to selected sections of WAC 480-07 – Procedural Rules, specifically WAC 480-07-110, WAC 480-07-125, WAC 480-07-140, WAC 480-07-160, WAC 480-07-307, WAC 480-07-395, WAC 480-07-510, WAC 480-07-710, WAC 480-07-900, WAC 480-07-903, WAC 480-07-904, and WAC 480-07-905. The rulemaking has been assigned Docket A-072162.

Statutes authorizing the agency to adopt rules on this subject: RCW 80.01.040(4), RCW 80.04.160, and RCW 34.05.020.

Reasons why rules on this subject may be needed and what they might accomplish: Since the Commission adopted rules related to delegation of certain Commission decisions in WAC 480-07, Procedural Rules, effective September 21, 2006, Commission Staff have identified a variety of issues that suggest the Commission should review the delegation rules to promote efficiency in the conduct of business before the Commission. At the same time, Commission Staff have also identified issues with other procedural rules in WAC 480-07.
