On March 31, 2009, the City of Cheney filed a Grade Crossing Protective Fund (GCPF) application with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (commission). The commission assigned docket number TR-090487 to this application. The City of Cheney requests \$20,000 to contribute toward a \$22,000 project to add sidewalks and fence a high trespassing location near the Cheney-Spangle Road (USDOT #065970L) crossing in the City of Cheney. The installation of sidewalks and fencing will improve pedestrian safety around the crossing.

The commission does not have available funding at this time to consider additional GCPF applications. Your GCPF application will be kept on file at the commission and evaluated when additional funding is available.
