- On April 2, 2009, Heaton Farms filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) an application for name change requesting authority to operate as a common carrier of hazardous materials in the state of Washington under RCW 81.80 and WAC 480-14. Heaton Farms' application is incomplete as it lacks the required USDOT hazardous materials permit.
- On April 7, May 19, July 8 and August 19, 2009, the Commission sent Heaton Farms notices to comply with the application requirements set forth in RCW 81.80 and WAC 480-14. Heaton Farms has not met these requirements as of the date of this Order.
- The application filed by Heaton Farms in Docket TV-090512 should be dismissed for failure to meet the application requirements in RCW 81.80 and WAC 480-14.

- THE COMMISSION ORDERS the application filed by Heaton Farms on April 2, 2009 in Docket TV-090512 for common carrier authority is dismissed.
- The Commission has delegated authority to the Secretary to enter this Order under RCW 80.01.030, WAC 480-07-903(1)(c).
