- On April 9, 2009, Panther II Transportation filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) an application requesting authority to operate as a common carrier in the state of Washington as required by the provisions of RCW 81.80 and WAC 480-14. Panther II Transportation 's application is incomplete as it lacks a Uniform Motor Carrier Certificate of Insurance (Form E), a correct UBI number, carrier ownership and officers, carrier equipment list and a USDOT hazardous material permit.
- The Commission sent Panther II Transportation two notices to comply with the application requirements set forth in RCW 81.80 and WAC 480-14. Panther II Transportation has not met these requirements as of the date of this Order.
- The application filed by Panther II Transportation in Docket TV-090519 should be dismissed for failure to meet the application requirements in RCW 81.80 and WAC 480-14.

- THE COMMISSION ORDERS That the application filed by Panther II Transportation in Docket TV-090519 for common carrier authority is dismissed.
- The Commission has delegated authority to the Secretary to enter this Order under RCW 80.01.030 and WAC 480-07-903(1)(c).
