



- 5 (3) Points Recycling and Refuse, LLC, is subject to [WAC 480-70-071](#), which requires solid waste companies to file an annual report by May 1 of each year.
- 6 (4) Under [WAC 480-70-071 \(1\)\(c\)](#), the Commission may grant an extension of time allowing the Company to file its annual report after the May 1 due date if the Commission receives a request for extension before May 1.
- 7 (5) This matter came before the Commission at its regularly scheduled meeting on April 30, 2009.
- 8 (6) After reviewing the Company's petition filed in Docket TG-090555 on April 20, 2009, and giving due consideration, the Commission finds that the exemption is in the public interest and is consistent with the purposes underlying the regulation and applicable statutes and should be granted to file its annual report on or before June 1, 2009.

**ORDER**

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS:**

- 9 (1) The request from Points Recycling and Refuse, LLC, for an exemption from WAC 480-70-071 and for an extension of time until June 1, 2009, to file its 2008 annual report is granted.
- 10 (2) Failure by Points Recycling and Refuse, LLC, to file its 2008 annual report by June 1, 2009, may result in the Commission invoking [RCW 81.04.405](#), which allows the Commission to assess penalties for violations of statute, rule, and commission orders.
- 11 (3) The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and Points Recycling and Refuse, LLC, to effectuate the provisions of this Order.

The Commissioners, having determined this Order to be consistent with the public interest, directed the Executive Director and Secretary to enter this Order.
