Rule 14 - Discontinuance of Service – (Cont'd)

The company will restore service when the cause of discontinuance has been removed and payment of all proper charges due from customer, including the Reconnection Charge set forth in this tariff, have been made.

Rule 15 – Outdoor Watering – Sprinkling, Irrigation, Pools, Hot Tubs, etc.

Water used for sprinkling and irrigation shall be paid for at the regular prescribed tariff rates for such service. The hours for such use shall be as prescribed from time to time by the company or as required by the Department of Health. In addition, the company may put restrictions on filling of swimming pools, hot tubs, etc.

No person shall use water for sprinkling or irrigation purposes during any fire in the area, and all sprinkling or irrigation shall be stopped immediately when an alarm of fire is sounded, and not resumed until the fire has been extinguished.

Each customer will follow a “best practices” approach to the use of irrigation service. This best practices approach includes the following:

- a. revisiting existing landscaping to determine if modifications are needed to reduce use of water;
- b. irrigating grass areas at a rate of no more than one (1) inch per week;
- c. sizing irrigation sprinklers or installing irrigation sprinklers to provide as near a uniform coverage of grass-landscaped areas as feasible;
- d. not using watering practices that involve a “sponge” approach where water is applied in one area with the thought that it will eventually provide coverage of other areas through the water traveling over, through or under the ground; and
- e. not irrigating when the temperature is forecasted to exceed ninety (90) degrees Fahrenheit.

Rule 15 – Outdoor Watering – Sprinkling, Irrigation, Pools, Hot Tubs, etc. – (Cont'd)

If the company issues a “no irrigation” order for the water system, the customer must immediately cease irrigation until the “no irrigation” order is lifted.

WATER AVAILABILITY LETTERS

Applicable

To owners, owners' agents and developers of property requesting water availability letters for the purpose of obtaining drainfield design approval and/or certificate of water availability for the purpose of obtaining building permits from the county.

Rate

Water availability letter - \$150.00
Certificate of water availability - \$150.00*

Conditions

1. Any owner, owners' agent or developer seeking a water availability letter or certificate of water availability from the company must first pay the appropriate charge set forth on this Schedule.
2. Water availability letters shall be valid for no more than twelve months from the date of issuance. Certificate of water availability shall be valid for no more than twelve months from the date of issuance.

*This charge is waived if a water availability letter has been previously issued.

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
