Dear Mr. Danner:

Please find attached copies of revisions for G-60 Tariff Number 27 for Fiorito Enterprises, Inc & Rabanco Companies (dba Kent-Meridian Disposal Company, Allied Waste of Kent). This proposed change in the tariff reflects the change in the commodity credit for residential customers in the Serivce Areas defined in Appendix A from a credit of \$0.54 to a debit of \$0.04 per month and for multi family customers, from a credit of \$0.05 to a credit of \$2.11 per yard. Enclosed are the accounting work papers.

As a result of the change in the law (HB 2539) additional time is needed by King County to review and certify the proposed plan. The requisite county revenue share letter outlining their approval of our request for retention of commodity credit revenue indicating expansion of recycling programs should be forthcoming under separate cover later this week
