- On September 3, 2010, Steve Carlton Construction, Inc., (Steve Carlton), filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) applications requesting a temporary and permanent certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a solid waste collection company in the state of Washington under RCW 81.77. Steve Carlton's applications were incomplete as they lacked the tariff and time schedule and a map of the service territory.
- On September 23, October 29, and December 3, 2010, the Commission sent Steve Carlton notices to comply with the application requirements in RCW 81.77 and WAC 480-70. Steve Carlton has not met these requirements as of the date of this Order.
- The applications filed by Steve Carlton in Dockets TG-101522 and TG-101523 should be dismissed for failure to meet the application requirements in RCW 81.77 and WAC 480-70.

## **ORDER**

- THE COMMISSION ORDERS the application filed by Steve Carlton Construction, Inc., on September 3, 2010 in Dockets TG-101522 and TG-101523 for a temporary and permanent certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a solid waste collection company are dismissed.
- The Commission has delegated authority to the Secretary to enter this Order under RCW 80.01.030 and WAC 480-07-905(5)(f).
