Dear Mr. Danner:

On December 8, 2010 Puget Sound Energy (the “Company”) filed with the Commission proposed changes to Schedule No. 1, Tax Adjustment affecting approximately 1,088 natural gas customers within the City of Medina. Pursuant to WAC 480-90-198, Notice Verification and Assistance, the Company is providing this statement that it has posted the above-referenced filing in accordance with WAC 480-90-193(1), Posting of Tariffs for Public Inspection and Review; Web, Telephone, and Mail Access.

The Company also states that notice to the public of the filing referenced above is being completed in accordance with WAC 480-90-195, Notice of Tariff Changes Other Than Increases in Recurring Charges and Restrictions in Access to Services. The following bill message is being provided to each affected natural gas customer with the first bill after the change became effective.

“The January 8, 2011 change in rates is the result of the City of Medina's new city tax. The city tax rate on your bill is 3.23%. This rate includes the effect of state and local taxes on the city tax and deductions allowed by the city.”
