- 1 On March 15, 2011, Tommy Reedy Trucking, LLC, (Tommy Reedy Trucking) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) an application requesting authority to operate as a common carrier in the state of Washington under RCW 81.80 and WAC 480-14. Tommy Reedy Trucking's application is incomplete as the LLC is not registered with the Washington Secretary of State.
- 2 On March 15, March 23, April 13, and May 12, 2011, the Commission sent Tommy Reedy Trucking notices to comply with the application requirements set forth in RCW 81.80 and WAC 480-14. Tommy Reedy Trucking has not met these requirements as of the date of this Order.
- 3 The application filed by Tommy Reedy Trucking in Docket TV-110489 should be dismissed for failure to meet the application requirements in RCW 81.80 and WAC 480-14.

**ORDER**

- 4 **THE COMMISSION ORDERS** the application filed by Tommy Reedy Trucking, LLC on March 15, 2011 in Docket TV-110489 for common carrier authority is dismissed.
- 5 The Commission has delegated authority to the Secretary to enter this Order under RCW 80.01.030, WAC 480-07-903(1)(c).

**NOTICE:** This is an order delegated to the Secretary for decision under RCW 80.01.030 and WAC 480-07-903(1)(c). You may seek Commission review of this decision by filing a request for Commission review of this order no later than twenty (20) days after the service date of the order.

The Commission will schedule your request for review by issuing a notice of hearing to be held before an administrative law judge. The Commission, at its discretion, may consider your request for review in an adjudicative proceeding under RCW 34.05 Part IV, or in a brief adjudicative proceeding under RCW 34.05.482 through .494. Following hearing, the administrative law judge will enter an initial order. If you wish to seek review of the initial order, you may file a petition for administrative review under RCW 34.05.464, or if the matter is heard in a brief adjudicative proceeding, under RCW 34.05.491.
