- 1 On June 4, 2011, Airline Shuttle, Inc. (Airline Shuttle, Inc.), filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) an application requesting authority to provide charter and excursion carrier service in the state of Washington under RCW 81.70. Airline Shuttle, Inc.'s application is incomplete as it lacks the corrected USDOT number: a Uniform Motor Carrier Certificate of Insurance (Form E), and a CVSA safety inspection of the vehicles.
- 2 On June 8, June 27 and July 29, 2011, the Commission sent Airline Shuttle, Inc., notices to comply with the application requirements in RCW 81.70 and WAC 480-30. Airline Shuttle, Inc., has not met these requirements as of the date of this Order.
- 3 The application filed by Airline Shuttle, Inc., in Docket TE-111012 should be dismissed for failure to meet the application requirements in RCW 81.70 and WAC 480-30.

ORDER

- 4 **THE COMMISSION ORDERS** the application filed by Airline Shuttle, Inc., on June 4, 2011, in Docket TE-111012 for charter and party excursion carrier service is dismissed.
- 5 The Commission has delegated authority to the Secretary to enter this Order under RCW 80.01.030 and WAC 480-07-905(5)(f).
