1 On August 1, 2011, Jose Esquivel Trucking LLC, (Jose Esquivel Trucking) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) an application requesting authority to operate as a common carrier in the state of Washington under RCW 81.80 and WAC 480-14. Jose Esquivel Trucking’s application is incomplete as the carrier’s USDOT number was placed Out Of Service (OOS) by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA) effective July 22, 2011.

2 The Washington State Department of Licensing revokes all commercial motor vehicle registrations for any Washington carrier that receives an OOS Order by FMCSA under RCW 46.16.615. Jose Esquivel Trucking is still under the FMCSA OOS Order and no valid vehicle registration information has been provided to the commission.

3 On August 1, the commission sent Jose Esquivel Trucking a notice of the Out Of Service Order. On August 24, and September 20, 2011, the Commission sent Jose Esquivel Trucking notices of the OOS Order and to comply with the application requirements set forth in RCW 81.80 and WAC 480-14. Jose Esquivel Trucking has not met these requirements as of the date of this Order.

4 The application filed by Jose Esquivel Trucking in Docket TV-111393 should be dismissed for failure to meet the application requirements in RCW 81.80 and WAC 480-14.

**ORDER**

5 **THE COMMISSION ORDERS** the application filed by Jose Esquivel Trucking LLC on August 1, 2011 in Docket TV-111393 for common carrier authority is dismissed.

- 6 The Commission has delegated authority to the Secretary to enter this Order under RCW 80.01.030, WAC 480-07-903(1)(c).

**NOTICE:** This is an order delegated to the Secretary for decision under RCW 80.01.030 and WAC 480-07-903(1)(c). You may seek Commission review of this decision by filing a request for Commission review of this order no later than twenty (20) days after the service date of the order.

The Commission will schedule your request for review by issuing a notice of hearing to be held before an administrative law judge. The Commission, at its discretion, may consider your request for review in an adjudicative proceeding under RCW 34.05 Part IV, or in a brief adjudicative proceeding under RCW 34.05.482 through .494. Following hearing, the administrative law judge will enter an initial order. If you wish to seek review of the initial order, you may file a petition for administrative review under RCW 34.05.464, or if the matter is heard in a brief adjudicative proceeding, under RCW 34.05.491.
