- 1 David S Church, d/b/a DC Transport, (DC Transport), has filed an application with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) for an extension of Common Carrier Permit Authority to include Hazardous Materials to existing permit authority CC-61995 to operate as a motor freight carrier within the state of Washington.
- 2 On August 15, 2012, DC Transport notified the Commission that it does not wish to proceed with the application for a common carrier permit and requested that this application be withdrawn and the proceeding dismissed.

- 3 **THE COMMISSION ORDERS** the application of David S Church, d/b/a DC Transport, filed in Docket TV-111592, is dismissed.

The Commission will schedule your request for review by issuing a notice of hearing to be held before an administrative law judge. The Commission, at its discretion, may consider your request for review in an adjudicative proceeding under RCW 34.05 Part IV, or in a brief adjudicative proceeding under RCW 34.05.482 through .494. Following hearing, the administrative law judge will enter an initial order. If you wish to seek review of the initial order, you may file a petition for administrative review under RCW 34.05.464, or if the matter is heard in a brief adjudicative proceeding, under RCW 34.05.491.
