- On December 28, 2011, Marihugh Enterprises Inc., (Marihugh) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) an application requesting a name change for CC-46581 permit authority to operate as a common carrier of motor freight in the state of Washington under RCW 81.80 and WAC 480-14.
