BACKGROUND	
On April 17, 2012, Freedom 2000, LLC (Freedom or Company) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) a petition requesting an extension of time to file its 2011 annual report as required by WAC 480-70-071. According to Freedom it is unable to prepare the report due to the time required to properly prepare it in accordance with Commission guidelines. Freedom seeks an extension until July 1, 2012,	
Commission Staff reviewed the request and recommended granting Freedom's request for exemption, subject to the condition that the Company file its completed report by July 1, 2012.	
FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS	
(1) The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission is an agency of the State of Washington vested by statute with the authority to regulate the rates, rules, regulations, practices, accounts and affiliated interests of public service companies, including solid waste companies. RCW 80.01.040, RCW 81.01, RCW 81.04, RCW 81.16, RCW 81.28 and RCW 81.77.	
(2) Freedom is a solid waste company and a public service company subject to Commission jurisdiction.	

Freedom is subject to WAC 480-70-071, which requires solid waste companies to

file an annual report by May 1 of each year.

6 (4) Under WAC 480-70-071 (1)(c), the Commission may grant an extension of time allowing the Company to file its annual report after the May 1 due date if the Commission receives a request for extension before May 1.

- 7 (5) This matter came before the Commission at its regularly scheduled meeting on April 26, 2012.
- 8 (6) After review of the petition filed in Docket TG-120517 by Freedom on April 17, 2012, and giving due consideration, the Commission finds that the exemption is in the public interest and is consistent with the purposes underlying the regulation and applicable statutes and should be granted.

ORDER

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- 9 (1) The request by Freedom 2000, LLC for an exemption from WAC 480-70-071 and for an extension until July 1, 2012, to file its 2011 annual report is granted.
- Failure by Freedom 2000, LLC to file its 2011 annual report by July 1, 2012, may result in the Commission invoking RCW 81.04.405, which allows the Commission to assess penalties for violations of statute, rule, and Commission orders.
- 11 (3) The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and Freedom 2000, LLC to effectuate the provisions of this Order.

The Commissioners, having determined this Order to be consistent with the public interest, directed the Secretary to enter this Order.
