Dear Mr. Danner:

Qwest Corporation d/b/a CenturyLink QC is forwarding for filing the replacement sheets listed on Attachment A.

This replacement decreases the federal lifeline credit (ASGFX) from \$5.77 to \$5.75. It also increases ASGF3 to \$3.50 in order to keep the total Lifeline credit at \$9.25. The federal lifeline credit is a direct offset to the Federal Access Charge for residential primary line customers. CenturyLink made an FCC filing on June 18, 2012, to change the federal access charge rate for Washington. There is no customer impact to this rate change, since the federal credit is a direct offset to the federal access charge

The requested effective date for this filing is August 1, 2012.
