Gentlemen:

This letter is your 75-day notice as required by RCW 70.95.212.

To make the administration of the rate changes more efficient, the effective date of the new disposal rates has been changed to **February 1, 2012**.

1. A \$6 per ton increase for solid waste delivered to Spokane Regional Solid Waste System facilities from \$98 per ton to \$104 per ton. There continues to be a \$5 per ton fee for waste delivered by certified haulers and other direct-hauled commercial waste delivered to either of the transfer stations, making the fee for commercial loads of solid waste \$109 per ton at the transfer stations.
2. A \$6 per ton increase for clean green yard waste delivered to Spokane Regional Solid Waste System facilities from \$35 per ton to \$41 per ton.

New disposal rates effective **January 1, 2013**, will be the following:

1. A \$3 per ton increase for solid waste from \$104 per ton to \$107 per ton. The fee for commercial loads of solid waste at the transfer stations will be \$112 per ton.
2. A \$3 per ton increase for clean green yard waste from \$41 per ton to \$44 per ton.

New disposal rates effective **January 1, 2014**, will be the following:

1. A \$3 per ton increase for solid waste from \$107 per ton to \$110 per ton. The fee for commercial loads of solid waste at the transfer stations will be \$115 per ton.
2. A \$3 per ton increase for clean green yard waste from \$44 per ton to \$47 per ton.
