24. Relevant Carrier History:

This is a newly formed company and no prior history is available for this carrier.

25. Findings:

This carrier owns one 47 passenger motor coach and one 22 passenger bus. The carrier's owner is Randy Ammerson, who also is owner and chief executive officer (CEO) of A & A Motorcoach in Yakima. Mr. Ammerson has hired an experienced motor coach operations manager, Keegan Bray as his Director of Operations for KJR Shuttle (KJR) to oversee this company's intrastate operation in the Wenatchee area. Journeyman motor coach and bus mechanic Vaughn Warren was hired to fill the role of chief safety manager for both A & A Motorcoach and KJR. Mr. Warren provided a tour of his maintenance facilities and office filing systems. His facility is well maintained and operated to ensure safety to passengers. Mr. Warren is also well versed in regulatory requirements for a commercial motor carrier company and a seasoned motor coach and passenger bus mechanic.

KJR does not have interstate authority, although may at a later time apply for this authority.

After inspecting KJR's two vehicles using level 5 procedures, no defects on either vehicle were discovered. Technical assistance and safety training was provided to Mr. Warren, with an extra amount of discussion time placed on medical certification requirements. Randy Ammerson and Keegan Bray were unable to attend the safety training due to other obligations. Mr. Warren will be the responsible person to ensure drivers are qualified before driving.

The UTC safety manual "Your Guide to Achieving a Satisfactory Safety Record" was provided to the carrier. The UTC and FMCSA web sites were also pointed out as information resource locations.

The carriers insurance policy was found to be valid with a CSL rating of \$5,000.000.00.

This carrier will operate as a charter transporter in and around the Wenatchee areas.
