Our company has been notified that as of May 1, 2013 the tipping fee at the Spokane Transfer Station will decrease from \$112.00 to \$103.00 per ton, a 8.04% decrease and at the Spokane Incinerator the rate will decrease from \$107.00 to \$98.00 per ton, a 8.41% decrease. We project this will decrease revenue and expense for residential service by \$10,394 and commercial service by \$3,894, for a 12-month period, for customers residing within Spokane County. Drop box service is projected to decrease by \$1,157 for a 12-month period. The last general rate increase approved by the Commission was effective November 1, 2010

Attached are revised tariff pages and supporting documentation containing the revised rates. If these rates are approved by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission they will become effective May 1, 2013. Pursuant to WAC 480-70-271(2)(a)(iii), affected customers will receive notification of the change on the first billing reflecting the revision to rates.
