- On March 28, 2013, Jason Boling, d/b/a JSB Logging, (JSB Logging) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) an application requesting authority to operate as a common carrier in the state of Washington under RCW 81.80 and WAC 480-14. JSB Logging's application is incomplete as it lacks a Uniform Motor Carrier Certificate of Insurance (Form E) and the USDOT number is not in the correct name.
- On March 28, May 1, and June 4, 2013, the Commission sent JSB Logging notices to comply with the application requirements set forth in RCW 81.80 and WAC 480-14. JSB Logging has not met these requirements as of the date of this Order.
- The application filed by JSB Logging in Docket TV-130441 should be dismissed for failure to meet the application requirements in RCW 81.80 and WAC 480-14.

- THE COMMISSION ORDERS the application filed by Jason Boling, d/b/a JSB Logging, on March 28, 2013 in Docket TV-130441 for common carrier authority is dismissed.
