

- 5 (3) Threshold Communications is subject to [WAC 480-120-382](#), which requires competitively classified telecommunications companies to file an annual report no later than May 1 of each year.
- 6 (4) Under [WAC 480-120-015](#), the Commission may grant an exemption from any rule in [WAC 480-120](#), if consistent with the public interest, the purposes underlying regulation and applicable statutes. See also [WAC 480-07-110](#).
- 7 (5) This matter came before the Commission at its regularly scheduled meeting on May 9, 2013.
- 8 (6) After review of the petition in Docket UT-130595 by Threshold Communications filed on April 23, 2013, and giving due consideration, the Commission finds that the exemption is in the public interest and is consistent with the purposes underlying the regulation and applicable statutes and should be granted.

O R D E R

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- 9 (1) The request by Threshold Communications, Inc., for an exemption from [WAC 480-120-382](#) and for an extension until July 1, 2013, to file its 2012 annual report is granted.
- 10 (2) Failure by Threshold Communications, Inc., to file its annual report by July 1, 2013, may result in the Commission invoking [RCW 80.04.405](#), which allows the Commission to assess penalties for violations of statute, rules and Commission orders.
- 11 (3) The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and Threshold Communications, Inc., to effectuate the provisions of this Order.

The Commissioners, having determined this Order to be consistent with the public interest, directed the Secretary to enter this Order.
