Evergreen Park Dr. SW, in Olympia. RCW 81.68.015 provides auto transportation companies' the opportunity to petition the Commission requesting forbearance from rate regulation. The Commission is accepting written comments regarding this proposal. Written comments must be submitted to the Commission no later than September 20 by 5 p.m. or comments may be presented during the scheduled open public meeting. People for People, in Docket TC-131520, proposes to provide auto transportation service using a grant issued by the Department of Transportation. The Company requests forbearance from rate regulation pursuant to RCW 81.68.015.

People for People proposes to provide auto transportation service between Grant County with stops at the Moses Lake Clinic, Columbia Basin Hospital in Ephrata, Quincy Valley Hospital, and Wenatchee Valley Medical Center in Chelan County. The purpose of this transportation is to connect special needs population with vital healthcare services not available in rural areas.

People for People asserts that the proposed service meets the criteria of funding by a grant issued by the Department of Transportation and should be allowed forbearance from rate regulation (RCW 81.68.051).
