- On October 28, 2013, Bryce E. St. Barber, d/b/a Barber Fast Freight, (Barber Fast Freight) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) an application requesting authority to operate as a common carrier in the state of Washington under RCW 81.80 and WAC 480-14. Barber Fast Freight's application is incomplete as the name associated with the USDOT number has to match how the name attached to the UBI number reads, and a Motor Carrier Certificate of Insurance was not received.
- On the following dates, October 28, November 25, and December 20, 2013, the Commission sent Barber Fast Freight notices to comply with the application requirements set forth in RCW 81.80 and WAC 480-14. Barber Fast Freight has not met these requirements as of the date of this Order.
- The application filed by Barber Fast Freight in Docket TV-132007 should be dismissed for failure to meet the application requirements in RCW 81.80 and WAC 480-14.

ORDER

- THE COMMISSION ORDERS the application filed by Bryce E. St. Barber, d/b/a Barber Fast Freight, on October 28, 2013 in Docket TV-132007 for common carrier authority is dismissed.
- The Commission has delegated authority to the Secretary to enter this Order under RCW 80.01.030 and WAC 480-07-903(1)(c).
