- 1 On January 22, 2014, National Luxury Coach LLC, filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) an application requesting authority to provide charter and excursion carrier service in the state of Washington under RCW 81.70. National Luxury Coach LLC’s application is incomplete as it lacks registration with the Secretary of State’s office as a Limited Liability Company.
- 2 On January 23, February 21, March 13, 2014, the Commission sent National Luxury Coach LLC notices to comply with the application requirements in RCW 81.70 and WAC 480-30. National Luxury Coach LLC has not met these requirements as of the date of this Order.
- 3 The application filed by National Luxury Coach LLC in Docket TE-140120 should be dismissed for failure to meet the application requirements in RCW 81.70 and WAC 480-30.

ORDER

- 4 **THE COMMISSION ORDERS** the application filed by National Luxury Coach LLC, on January 22, 2014 in Docket TE-140120 for charter and party excursion carrier service is dismissed.
- 5 The Commission has delegated authority to the Secretary to enter this Order under RCW 80.01.030 and WAC 480-07-905(5)(f).
