- 8 (6) After review of the petition in Docket UT-140670 by Network Innovations filed on April 21, 2014, and giving due consideration, the Commission finds that the exemption is in the public interest and is consistent with the purposes underlying the regulation and applicable statutes and should be granted.

ORDER

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- 9 (1) The request by Network Innovations, Inc., for an exemption from WAC 480-120-382 and for an extension until July 1, 2014, to file its 2013 annual report is granted.
- 10 (2) Failure by Network Innovations, Inc., to file its annual report by July 1, 2014, may result in the Commission invoking RCW 80.04.405, which allows the Commission to assess penalties for violations of statute, rules and Commission orders.
- 11 (3) The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and Network Innovations, Inc., to effectuate the provisions of this Order.

The Commissioners, having determined this Order to be consistent with the public interest, directed the Secretary to enter this Order.
