Puget Sound Energy, Inc. This substitute filing is pursuant to RCW 80.28.060 and Chapter 480-80 WAC and includes the following portion of the Company’s WN U-60, Tariff G for electric service:

The two purposes of this substitute filing are to: 1) revise the cover letter to include Sheet 194-B; and 2) include a new Section 8 describing the interest that will accrue on the amounts received from the Bonneville Power Administration in settlement of the Interim Agreement True-up Payment Amounts under the 2008 Residential Exchange Interim Relief and Standstill Agreements (“Settlement Benefits”). The pass through of the Settlement Benefits are the primary purpose of this filing.

This substitution is provided for in WAC 480-80-111(a) as the revision addresses concerns of the Commission with the pending tariff sheets. The tariff sheet described herein reflects the original filing issue date of April 30, 2014, and the original filing effective date of June 1, 2014.
