Puget Sound Energy, Inc. (“PSE”) hereby submits in connection with Docket No. UE-141213, the following substitute tariff sheets and replacement cover letter to replace the cover letter accompanying the Company’s May 30, 2014, filing which was submitted under PSE’s Advice No. 2014-19 and add a tariff sheet to that filing. This substitute filing is pursuant to RCW 80.28.060 and Chapter 480-80 WAC and includes the following portion of the Company’s WN U-60, Tariff G for electric service:

The two purposes of this substitute filing are to: 1) revise the cover letter to include Sheet 142-A; and 2) correct a schedule number on Sheet 142-D. Sheet 142-A is being added to reflect the lower Monthly Allowed Delivery Revenue Per Customer as stated in the original cover letter, the sheet itself was missed when the original filing was prepared. On Sheet 142-D changes were made for clarity but an incorrect schedule number was referenced in that clarification.

This substitution is provided for in WAC 480-80-111(b) as the changes do not increase rates in the pending tariff sheets. The tariff sheets described herein reflect the original filing issue date of May 30, 2014, and the original filing effective date of July 1, 2014.
