Dear Mr. King:

Please find attached revised tariff page revisions for G-12 tariff number 4 for Rabanco Ltd. (dba Republic Services, &, Lynnwood Disposal). This proposed change in the tariff reflects the change in the commodity credit for single family residential customers in the Service Areas defined in Appendices A and B from a credit of \$0.74 to a credit of \$0.88 per month and for multi family customers, from a credit of \$0.33 to a credit of \$0.97 per yard. The related accounting work papers are included in this submission to accompany the replacement tariff pages. As stated before, we are asking that the rates become effective August 1, 2014.
