IMPORTANT NOTICE

Ellensburg Telephone Company has filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission ("Commission") to increase its Residential Exchange Access Line Service from \$14.00 to \$16.00 per month and its Business Exchange Access Line Service from \$16.52 to \$18.52, a change of \$2.00 per month. The Company also proposes to increase the rates for all voice packages, excluding Voice Advantage II and ExpansionPAK II packages, by \$2.00 per month.

The residential rates are being increased to meet the Federal Communications Commission's urban rate floor requirements and the business rates are being increased to retain the distinction between residential and business rates.

If you have any questions about the proposed filing and how it will affect you, please call the Company at 800-400-5568.

The Commission has the authority to set rates that may vary from the Company's request, depending on the outcome of its investigation. Commission staff will make a recommendation to the commissioners at an open meeting in Olympia, which is scheduled for 9:30 a.m. on October 30, 2014. You will have an opportunity to comment in person at this meeting. If you are unable to attend the open meeting, the Commission has a bridge line which enables you to participate by telephone.
