Attention Basic Residential Service and Total Talk Customers - Proposed Rate Increase:

TDS Telecom has filed proposed increases to basic residential service rates due to regulatory reforms issued by the Federal Communications Commission and the Washington Utilities & Transportation Commission. These rates will go into effect on November 7th 2014 if they are approved by the Washington Utilities & Transportation Commission. If approved, your rate for basic residential service to Total Talk package will increase \$2.00 on your November bill. The basic residential service rate will change from \$14.00 to \$16.00 and the Total Talk package rate will change from \$25.55 to \$27.55. If you subscribe to a Star Package you will not be affected by this rate change.
