- 1 On November 12, 2015, Johnson’s Hauling LLC, d/b/a Johnson’s Hauling & Moving, filed an application with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) to reinstate its temporary household goods carrier authority in the state of Washington under RCW 81.80 and WAC 480-15, rules relating to motor carriers of household goods.
- 2 The Commission, having considered the application and being fully advised, finds that it would be in the public interest to grant the application to reinstate provisional household goods carrier permit THG-65626, to Johnson’s Hauling LLC, d/b/a Johnson’s Hauling & Moving, under WAC 480-15-450(4)(a).

ORDER

- 3 **THE COMMISSION ORDERS** the application of Johnson’s Hauling LLC, d/b/a Johnson’s Hauling & Moving, for temporary motor carrier of household goods authority in the state of Washington is granted and permit THG-65626 is reissued.
- 4 The authority granted in this order is effective until the Commission by further order, grants, denies, or dismisses the application for permanent authority or otherwise cancels the authority granted.
- 5 The Commission has delegated authority to the Secretary to enter this Order under RCW 80.01.030 and WAC 480-07-905(1)(a).

NOTICE: This is an order delegated to the Secretary for decision. In addition to serving you a copy of the decision, the Commission will post on its Internet Web site for at least 14 days a listing of all matters delegated to the Secretary for decision. You may seek Commission review of this decision. You must file a request for Commission review of this order no later than fourteen (14) days after the date the decision is posted on the Commission's Web site.

The Commission will schedule your request for review by issuing a notice of hearing to be held before an administrative law judge. The Commission, at its discretion, may consider your request for review in an adjudicative proceeding under RCW 34.05 Part IV, or in a brief adjudicative proceeding under RCW 34.05.482 through .494. Following hearing, the administrative law judge will enter an initial order. If you wish to seek review of the initial order, you may file a petition for administrative review under RCW 34.05.464, or if the matter is heard in a brief adjudicative proceeding, under RCW 34.05.491.

The Commission will grant a late-filed request for review only on a showing of good cause, including a satisfactory explanation of why the person did not timely file the request. A form for late-filed requests is available on the Commission's Web site.

This notice and review process is pursuant to the provisions of RCW 80.01.030 and WAC 480-07-904(2) and (3), and WAC 480-07-905, as amended effective September 24, 2015.
