Dear CenturyLink,

[REDACTED] is requesting to obtain a block of [REDACTED] DID's for use at our new Seattle location. These DID's are needed for our planned relocation from [REDACTED]. The requirement is for the block to share a common NXX prefix within 206. The NXX prefix cannot begin with a 9. We would like the DID's by April 15, 2016.

The size of the campus, day one, will have capacity for [REDACTED] employees. There is also space on the property for another building as we continue to expand through [REDACTED] growth. The block of [REDACTED] will support FTEs, conference rooms, video conferencing use, etc.

We are applying for an [REDACTED] with the City of Seattle. That would allow us to plan growth at this location for the [REDACTED]. The allocation of 10,000 lines allows us to align with future growth beyond our Day 1 move-in.

We will move in [REDACTED] (exact dates are TBD). Our plan is to move all employees currently in the Bellevue location within 2-3 months to this site.

Once this location is operational, we plan to give the [REDACTED] back to CenturyLink shortly after the move is complete. At this time there is no plan for call forwarding services but it is being considered to give our users 4-5 months to update.

While we will not need all [REDACTED] We are looking to block out what we anticipate as a maximum requirement for maximum population (as approved by City of Seattle and its agencies). The contiguous block will allow us to scale with the new property and maintain a contiguous range.
