On May 11, 2017, Worrell, Richard D., d/b/a A-AAA Rich's Reliable Movers, filed an application with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) to reinstate the company's permit to provide residential household goods transportation services in the state of Washington.

The Commission grants Worrell, Richard D.'s request to reinstate permit HG064537 for permanent household goods carrier authority and approves the application in full. Permit HG064537 issued in the name of Worrell, Richard D. is enclosed, and the company may operate on a permanent basis.
