Re: Status of Compliance of Companies Named in the Notice of Intent to Cancel TG-170916

Dear Mr. King,

On Friday, September 1, 2017, the Commission served a Notice of Intent to Cancel Solid Waste Collection Certificate and Opportunity to Request a Hearing (Notice) on four solid waste collection companies. The Notice informed each company that the Commission intends to cancel its authority unless, within 30 days, the company comes into compliance with applicable law by (1) submitting the delinquent annual report and/or paying the required regulatory fee or (2) requesting a hearing to demonstrate why the company's authority should not be canceled. The thirty days elapsed on October 1, 2017. As of Friday, October 6, 2017, all four of the companies have come into compliance with annual report and regulatory fee submission requirements. The four companies are:

Bed Rock, Inc.  
DB Hauling, LLC  
Emerald Services, Inc.  
Mountain Barge Services, LLC

Because these companies have come into compliance, the Commission need not cancel the associated certificates and the docket should be closed.
