Present provisions are: Renewable generation incentives are currently addressed in PacifiCorp's Schedule 135.

Proposed changes are: Remove renewable generation incentive language from Schedule 135 and create new Schedule 137 for renewable generation incentive information in compliance with changes made in ESSB 5939.


Indicate below, or attach, an explanation of the reason the company requests permission to file the proposed provisions with less than statutory notice and to provide notification to customers on less than required notice.

Effective October 1, 2017, customers who have their renewable generation system certified with the Program Administrator, as defined by Senate Bill 5939, will receive an incentive as determined by the Program Administrator. In accordance with WAC 480-80-122, PacifiCorp requests the Commission allow the tariff changes to become effective with less than statutory notice. Allowing less than statutory notice allows the Company's tariffs to be amended by October 1, 2017 in accordance with Senate Bill 5939. There will be no change in rates to customers.
