Electric Tariff Filing - Filed Electronically**

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Dear Mr. King,

Puget Sound Energy (“PSE”) hereby submits in connection with Docket No. UE-171094 the following tariff sheet to replace the tariff sheet accompanying PSE’s November 1, 2017, filing which was submitted under PSE’s Advice No. 2017-18. This filing includes the following portion of the Company’s WN U-60 tariff for electric service.

8th Revision of Sheet No. 83-G – Electricity Conservation Service (Continued)

The primary purpose of this filing is to make updates to the Sheet No. 83-G to be consistent with the portion of the Commission's Order 08, Final Order Rejecting Tariff Sheets; and Authorizing and Requiring Compliance Filing, in consolidated Dockets UE-170033 and UG-170034 (the “Order”) that addresses the approval and adoption of the Settlement Stipulation. Specifically this necessitates PSE’s adjustment of its Energy Efficiency electric (Schedule 83) and natural gas (Schedule 183) Portfolio budgets: (1) PSE will add \$2 million in Low Income Weatherization funding between January 1, 2018 and June 30, 2019; and (2) PSE commits to acquire an incremental 5 percent therm savings over its indicated 2018-2019 Total Biennial Potential of 6.155 million therms in order to be granted natural gas decoupling. Implementation of these requirements caused the electric budget of \$180.71 million in the originally-filed Tariff Sheet 83-G to increase to \$181.68 million.¹ Similarly, PSE revised the natural gas budget from the November 1 total of \$29.59 million to \$31.07 million.

The tariff sheets described herein reflect the original issue dates of November 1, 2017, and effective dates of January 1, 2018. Posting of proposed tariff changes, as required by WAC 480-100-193, is being made by posting the proposed tariff sheets on the PSE web site immediately prior to or coincident with the date of this transmittal letter.

¹ Both of these amounts exclude the anticipated expenditure of \$2.16 million for PSE’s Net Metering program administration, which remained unchanged from the November 1 filing.
