Enclosed is a new Tariff No. 4 to replace Tariff No. 3 of Torre Refuse & Recycling d/b/a Sunshine Disposal & Recycling (G-260) in Spokane County.

This new tariff contains the following changes from the previous tariff:

- Updates customer rates to reflect the changes in disposal fees at the City of Spokane's Waste to Energy Facility
- Updates the residential commodity credit for residential curbside recycling customers.
- Removes differentiated rate pages between Incorporated City customers and Unincorporated County customers.

The revenue impact of this filing is approximately \$58,000 or about 1.3% on regulated revenue. This tariff services approximately 6,000 residential and 680 commercial customers in Western Spokane County.
