Dear Mr. Johnson:

Please find attached revised tariff page revisions for G-12 tariff number 4 for Rabanco Ltd. (dba Republic Services of Lynnwood, Lynnwood Disposal). This proposed change in the tariff reflects the change in the commodity credit for single family residential customers in the Service Areas defined in Appendices A and B from a credit of \$0.104 to a debit of \$0.215 per month and for multifamily customers, from a credit of \$0.051 to a debit of \$0.039 per yard. Due to the volatility of the current recycling market conditions, Republic Services is requesting a waiver from WAC 480-70-351 (2) and requesting to use the value of the most recent six-month historical period in estimating the revenue for the next six months. The related accounting work papers are included in this submission to accompany the replacement tariff pages. We are asking that the rates become effective February 1, 2019 – July 31, 2019.
