Dear Mr. Johnson:

Effective July 2, 2019, Consolidated Communications of Washington Company, LLC is electing incentive regulation for its interstate Business Data Services pursuant to Title 47, Part 61.50 of the Federal Communications Commission's rules. As a result, Consolidated Communications of Washington Company, LLC is withdrawing its Special Access services from the NECA Tariff F.C.C. No. 5 and moving them either to a new interstate access tariff, Consolidated Communications Companies Tariff F.C.C. No. 9, or to a Service Guide for detariffed services as outlined in section 61.50.

Currently, Consolidated Communications of Washington Company, LLC concurs with the regulations, terms, rates and charges in NECA Tariff F.C.C. No. 5 for Special Access services with speeds higher than a DS3. As Part 61.50 allows the detariffing of Special Access services with speeds higher than a DS3, these services will reside in the Consolidated Communications Companies Service Guide No. 2 effective July 2, 2019. This filing modifies the Consolidated Communications of Washington Company, LLC WN U-1 tariff to remove a reference to NECA Tariff F.C.C. No. 5 and replace it with a reference to the Consolidated Communications Companies Service Guide No. 2 pertaining to concurrence for Special Access services with speeds higher than a DS3.
