Washington Damage Complaint Avista vs Halme Construction

Alleged Violation:

19.122.040 (2) An excavator shall use reasonable care to avoid damaging underground facilities. An excavator must (a) determine the precise location of underground facilities that have been marked;

19.122.030 (6) (c) A facility operator's markings of underground utilities expire forty-five (45) calendar days from the date that the excavator provided notice to a one-number locator service pursuant to subsection (1) of this section. For excavation occurring after that date, an excavator must provide additional notice to a one-number locator service pursuant to subsection (1) of this section.

Summary of Alleged Violation:


Halme Construction was working on an excavation project along the 900 block of E 3rd Ave. Avista was in the process of lowering a shallow 2" steel main along 3rd Ave between Scott and Arthur. Avista made sure that Halme and all their employees knew that the line was shallow and needed to be lowered before they could cut the subgrade in this area. This was determined by potholing and taking measurements and then backfilling the holes.

Before Avista could get the 2" steel main lowered, Halme's trackhoe operator, KC, came in and started cutting the subgrade. KC did not determine the precise location of the marked service lateral prior to cutting the grade and tore Avista's ¾" steel service tee to 960 E. 3rd Ave off of the 2" steel main. See Attachment #1 - #4 showing a vicinity map and photos of the damage.

Halme told Avista's first responder that it was a miscommunication and that the operator was not supposed to be digging in that area. Regardless of the miscommunication, Halme was required by 19.122.040 (2)(a) to determine the precise location of the marked facility. The locate mark in **Attachment #2** clearly shows that there is a service lateral.

Halme Construction was also found to be digging with an expired locate ticket. The damage occurred on 5/22/19 and ticket 19095980 expired on 5/3/19. During a ticket search there was no updated ticket found nor was there another locate ticket that was found for Halme Construction for 3rd Ave in this area. **See Attachment #5 and #6 for locate ticket and search information.**
