Re: PacifiCorp's Commission Basis Report for period ended December 2019

PacifiCorp dba Pacific Power & Light Company submits its 2019 Commission Basis Report in accordance with WAC 480-100-257. This annual report summarizes actual and normalized results of operations for the twelve months ended December 31, 2019, as assigned and allocated to Washington electric utility operations. This report is based on recorded costs allocated using the West Control Area Inter-Jurisdictional Allocation Methodology (WCA). In Order 01 in Docket UE-200362, the Commission granted PacifiCorp an extension to file the Commission Basis Report by May 15, 2020.

In compliance with Order 12 in Docket UE-152253, PacifiCorp also submits a report of decommissioning and remediation expenses and revenues for the coal-fired generating plants in the WCA.¹
