Enclosed, please find revised pages 2, 20, 22, 23, 24, 25, 27, 28, 30, 31, 34, 35, 40, 41, 42, 43, 44, 45, and 46 to the above-referenced tariff. The purpose of this filing is to increase rates to reflect the change in the state B & O tax rate from 1.5% to 1.75% which went into effect on April 1, 2020. The increased rates if approved by the Commission, would increase Company revenue by approximately \$172,000.

Also enclosed are our accounting workpapers which include a price-out calculating how the current tariff rates are being increased to the proposed rates. Customers will be notified of this change in their rates with their first invoice after the Commission's approval.
