Re: UG-200964—2021 Annual Conservation Report on NW Natural's Energy Efficiency Program

Northwest Natural Gas Company, dba NW Natural (NW Natural or the Company) hereby files the 2021 Annual Conservation Report on the Company's Energy Efficiency program. This report is submitted in compliance with the Company's 2021 Energy Efficiency Plan, which was filed and allowed to become effective in docket UG-200964.

In 2021, the Company's Energy Efficiency program for residential and commercial customers saved 345,322 therms at a cost of \$3.1 million. The Washington Low-Income Energy Efficiency program saved 3,568 therms at a cost of \$72,326. In addition, at a cost of 88,148 for the Northwest Energy Efficiency Alliance natural gas market transformation effort saved 11,423 therms. The Company's share of the Regional Technical Forum was \$10,300.

In compliance with the oversight agreed to and detailed in NW Natural's tariff Schedule G, the Company shared with the Energy Efficiency Advisory Group (EEAG) a draft of the 2021 results at the Q1 EEAG call on March 22, 2022 and provided a draft of the 2021 Annual Conservation Report with the EEAG on May 11, 2022.
