Dear Mr. Hollkamp:

As you are aware, on September 13, 2021, the Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a penalty assessment against Callbox Storage in the amount of \$6,200 for violations of the Commission's rules and laws. The penalty was due 15 days after the company's receipt of that notice. On November 3, 2021, a Final Notice was sent to Callbox Storage in the amount of \$6,200, which was due on receipt. To date, the Commission has not received the balance due.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You will likely incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest.
