In that time, Rubatino Refuse Removal, Inc. has experienced significant increases in costs that are essential to delivering services, including labor, fringe benefits, insurance, fuel, maintenance expenses, along with federal and state employment taxes. In addition, the company continues to acquire new assets to ensure it can deliver the safest, most efficient and reliable service possible. If approved, the proposed rates will become effective on October 1, 2021.
